3. Dinner, evening event

A dinner is foreseen for the meeting on the evening of 24th September. DAREnet will cover the costs for this dinner. We are currently in negotiations with several restaurants and will provide you with further details soon.

4. Venue and Logistics

The meeting will take place at the Austrian Red Cross Disaster Relief Center (ÖRK Katastrophenhilfezentrum), located in **Oberlaaer Str. 306, 1230 Vienna, Austria**.

How to reach the meeting venue

Coming by plane (from Vienna International Airport – Wien Schwechat):

Going to Wien Mitte (Landstrasse) and then to the meeting venue

The City Airport Train CAT offers a very fast way to travel to Vienna city center. Trains are departing every 30 mins from the airport, travel time to the city is approx. 16 minutes. Trains arrive at <u>Wien Mitte</u>, where you have connections to the metro lines U3 and U4. A single trip costs 12 EUR (11 EUR when bought online) which does not include public transport in Vienna. Tickets can be bought at the counter, at ticket vending machine, from sales staff or online. Further information on the CAT can be found at https://www.cityairporttrain.com/en/home.

Alternatively, you can take the rapid transit railway (S-Bahn) line S7 to Wien Mitte. Travel time for this option is approx. 25 minutes, a single trip will cost 4,20 EUR including public transport in Vienna. Tickets can be purchased at the OEBB ticket counter, at vending machines or online at www.oebb.at. The OEBB ticket counter can be found in the arrivals hall and the ticket machines are located in the arrivals hall, the passages to the platforms and on the platforms. The platforms at Vienna Airport can be reached directly, without any barriers and protected from the weather on a short walk from the arrivals hall.

From Wien Mitte (Landstrasse), you can take the metro (U-Bahn) to the meeting venue.

Going to Vienna Central Station (Wien Hauptbahnhof) and then to the meeting venue

Vienna Central Station can easily be reached by high speed trains (Railjet) from the airport. Trains leave regularly and approx. every 30 minutes; the travel time takes approx. 15-20 mins. A single trip will cost from 4,20 EUR including public transport in Vienna. Tickets can be



purchased at the OEBB ticket counter, at vending machines or online at www.oebb.at. The OEBB ticket counter can be found in the arrivals hall and the ticket machines are located in the arrivals hall, the passages to the platforms and on the platforms. The platforms at Vienna Airport can be reached directly, without any barriers and protected from the weather on a short walk from the arrivals hall.

Alternatively, you can take the bus from the airport to Vienna Central Station. Vienna Airport Lines (Postbus) connects Vienna Airport with the main Vienna transport hubs.

The 3 <u>Vienna Airport Lines</u> routes serve all of Vienna's underground railway lines. Every 30 minutes there are connections from the airport to Vienna Central Station. Buses to the city centre (Morzinplatz/Schwedenplatz) run 24 hours a day, journey time is around 20-25 minutes. Tickets cost 8 EUR for a single trip and 13 EUR for a return trip. You can purchase your ticket from the driver of the bus in person or online at the operator's website.

Coming by metro ("U-Bahn"):

From <u>Wien Mitte</u>, take the metro (U-Bahn) line U3 to Ottakring and change at **Stephansplatz**. Take the U1 direction Wien Oberlaa and get off **Alaudagasse**. Take either bus 67A INZERSDORF or 67B ALTERLAA, get off at **Oberlaaer Straße**. From the bus stop, it's a 5 minutes' walk to the meeting venue.

From <u>Vienna Central Station</u>, you can take the metro (U-Bahn) to the meeting venue. Take Metro line U1 direction Wien Oberlaa and get off **Alaudagasse**. Take either bus 67A INZERSDORF or 67B ALTERLAA, get off at **Oberlaaer Straße**. From the bus stop, it's a 5 minutes' walk to the meeting venue.

Single tickets, multiple tickets for 2, 4 or 8 rides or for 1, 3 or 8 days, and weekly tickets can be purchased from vending machines in all U-Bahn stations or at tobacco shops marked Tabak Trafik. Tickets: Single Ticket (€ 2,40), 24 Hour Pass (€ 8,00), 48 Hour Pass (€ 14,10), 72 Hour Pass (€ 17,10). Further info: Ticket Guide | Passenger Information | Wiener Linien

Going by Taxi


There are several taxis in front of the arrivals hall, which will bring you to the meeting venue directly. The cost for the trip will depend on traffic and should range around 40-50 EUR. Please note, if you are approached in the arrivals hall for taxi service, it is in your best interest not to use it. This is an illegal business conducted by people who in many cases also do not have the required business license.


